When introducing him. "His Grace, The Duke of Montrose" When addressing him directly it would be "Your Grace".

The Marquess of Graham, James Graham

Should be introduced as "His Lordship, The Marquess of Graham". When addressing him directly it would be Lord Graham.

Sir Malcolm R. Colquhoun, Chief of Clan Colquhoun

Should be introduced as Sir Malcolm Colquhoun When addressing him it would Sir Malcolm.

Lady Colquhoun of Luss

Should be introduces as Lady Colquhoun of Luss When addressing her directly, it is Lady Colquhoun and *not* Lady Katharine.

Patrick Colquhoun, son and heir of Sir Malcolm is formally introduced as Patrick Colquhoun, Younger of Luss.
When addressing him it is Patrick

His wife is Lottie Colquhoun, wife of Patrick Colquhoun Younger of Luss is formally introduced as Lottie Colquhoun, Younger of Luss. When addressing her it is Lottie

The Buchanan, John Michael Baillie-Hamilton Buchanan should be referred to as "The Buchanan".

When addressing him directly it would be, The Buchanan

The Lady Buchanan - Paula Buchanan

When introducing it is The Lady Buchanan When addressing it is Lady Buchanan

Daughter Lucy is introduced as The Miss Buchananof Buchanan When addressing her it is Lucy

Son and heir, Angus is introduced as Angus Buchanan, Younger of Buchanan When addressing it is Angus

Son Rory is The Buchanan of Auchleshie. When addressing it is Rory

Madame Pauline Hunter of Hunterston, Chief of Clan Hunter.

She is addressed as Madame Pauline.

When introducing it is Sir John MacEwen, Commander of Clan MacEwen When addressing it is Sir John
