



## Official Procedure for Access and Tours of Rossdhu House

---

### Overview

Rossdhu House, the ancestral seat of the Colquhoun family, is part of a private Members Club and is not open to the public. The **only authorized channel** for arranging visits is through the **Clan Colquhoun International Society (CCIS)**. All access is by prior arrangement and must be formally approved by the Society.

---

### 1. Eligibility Requirements

- Only *registered* members of the Clan Colquhoun International Society who are **in good standing** are eligible to request a visit.
  - Membership status will be confirmed prior to any arrangements.
- 

### 2. Official Access Point

- All visit requests must be made **directly through the Clan Colquhoun International Society**.
  - **No local arrangements or direct contact with Rossdhu or its staff are permitted.**
  - Members must use the contact form or email address listed on the official Clan Colquhoun website.

### 3. Tour Arrangements

- Once approved, CCIS will coordinate the visit with Rossdhu House and its estate representatives.
  - Visits are by prior appointment only and are subject to the availability of the estate.
  - All tours are **hosted and guided**, providing access to key interior rooms and historically significant areas of the grounds.

### 4. Conduct and Restrictions



- Visitors must comply fully with all instructions provided by CCIS and the estate.
  - Photography, filming, and entry into restricted areas are not permitted unless explicitly authorized.
  - All visitors are expected to show respect for the estate, its heritage, and the conditions under which access is granted.

## **5. Non-Members**

- Individuals who are not members, or whose membership is not current or in good standing, will not be eligible to request access.
- Prospective members may apply for membership through the official Clan Colquhoun website.
